Job Description

Position: Babysitter

General description:

Appointed by the Board and reporting to the Club Directors, this position is responsible for taking care of children (ages 0-10), at ZZYC, while their parents/guardians participate in ZZYC programs or events. Adherence to Club COVID-19 protocols is mandatory.

Specific responsibilities include:

- 1. Above all else, ensure the safety of the children under your care.
- 2. Instill good manners and a sense of responsibility in children under your care.
- 3. Ensure all children wear their life vests when playing outside (at your discretion, you may make exceptions for when on the ZZYC upper deck or in enclosed tennis court area).
- 4. Create a safe, nurturing and stimulating environment, by preparing and offering options of toys, games, crafts, etc., as appropriate.
- 5. For younger children or babies, you may be asked by a parent to feed the child a snack, change a diaper, apply sunscreen, etc. Tasks of this nature should be done only at the parent's instruction, and only with food/drink/diapers/wipes/sunscreens etc. provided by the parent.
- 6. Always ensure the materials used are clean/sanitary before and after each session. Toys and crafts should be put away neatly in designated areas when done using.
- Giving corrective instructions to children is encouraged where necessary. No further disciplinary actions will be required of babysitters. If any child is too unruly, report to the supervisor on duty – parents may need to be asked to come get the child.

Skills and Qualifications:

- 1+ years' babysitting or child care experience
- Recent babysitting course certificate, or CPR training are definite assets, but not required
- Appropriate verbal communication skills
- Organizational and multitasking abilities

Anticipated time demands (after initial familiarization period): Flexible, depending on the demand. The orientation sessions are mandatory.

Salary: Commensurate with experience and training according to provincial pay scale.
