Position: Bartender/Server

General description:

Appointed by the Board and reporting to the Club Director, this position is responsible for the service of beverages and food to guests in a prompt, efficient and above all, friendly and courteous manner. Our servers are focused on customer service. Adherence to Club COVID-19 protocols is mandatory.

Specific responsibilities include:

- 1. Welcome guests as they arrive and if necessary, find them an area to sit.
- 2. Guide guests through the food & beverage offerings, answer questions, make recommendations, and suggest appropriate options if required.
- 3. Assist in the training and development of new employees when required.
- 4. Maintain a positive attitude that promotes teamwork.
- 5. Perform various guest services by taking orders, serving food and beverages to the guests promptly.
- 6. Collect payments from guests in a timely manner.
- 7. Check with guests to ensure that they are enjoying their order and take action to correct any problems.
- 8. Clean tables or counters after guests have departed.
- 9. Stock & re-plenish service areas that have depleted (beverages, napkins, ice, etc.) Perform cleaning duties, such as loading/unloading the dishwasher, sweeping, tidying up kitchen area, taking out the trash, checking and cleaning the bathrooms, etc.
- 10. Other duties as required.

Skills and Qualifications:

- Must be of legal age to serve alcohol (age 18)
- Must be Smart Serve certified, or willing to complete the online Smart Serve course before July.
- Customer service skills able to exceed guest expectations.
- Previous serving experience preferred, but not necessary.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Must be able to work a flexible schedule including weekday afternoon/evenings and weekends
- Must be able to work with minimal supervision and have a strong initiative.

Anticipated time demands (after initial familiarization period): Flexible, depending on the scheduled events. The orientation sessions are mandatory.
